

THE PETROLEUM (QUALITY CONTROL) ACT

REQUIREMENTS FOR

PETROLEUM HAULAGE CONTRACTORS LICENCE

- **Completed application for Haulage Contractor Licence in duplicate**
- **Copy of a valid calibration certificate (Issued by the Bureau of Standards in respect of each tank truck or tanker wagon that is intended for haulage of petroleum products except LPG and LNG)**
- **Copy of a valid Pressure Testing Certificate for Tanks or Tanker Wagon that is intended for haulage of Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) and Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) from an examiner/entity approved by the Ministry of Labour and Social Security**
- **Copy of a valid:**
 - **Motor Vehicle Registration Certificate**
 - **Certificate of Fitness**
 - **Motor Vehicle Insurance Certificate**
- **Evidence of Insurance Coverage of not less than Twenty Million Jamaican Dollars (\$20,000,000.00) with respect to damage of any kind to premises, injury to any person or otherwise which may occur during the conveyance of petroleum (Third Party Liability/Road Risk)**
- **Evidence that the Licenced Haulage Contractor has secured Life Insurance for Tanker Driver(s) authorised to haul petroleum products on their behalf.**
- **Evidence/Proof of Agreement with Bulk Distributors, Producer, Importer etc.**
- **Copy of the Certificate of Incorporation (if a company) or Copy of a Valid Identification (if a Sole Trader)**
- **Copy of a Valid Tax Compliance Certificate**
